Message from the Chairman

Welcome to Rural Past Time 2026.

We try to provide an insight into the working world of farming and rural life through the ages, this includes country pursuits, crafts, and cottage industries, but also life outside of Farming.

Last years show had a fantastic selection of Steam Engines, working horses, Cars and Tractors just to mention a few. We also had a vast selection of trade stands, collections and autojumbles for all to peruse. This year we have much more for your enjoyment, We planted around 1.5 acres of corn for cutting.

Demonstrations of a Binder and Combining, then demonstrations of the Threshing Machine which separates the corn from the straw and is then left ready for Bailing. The ground can then be Ploughed and Cultivated by the working Horses and Tractors ready for re seeding for the next year. We also have a pair of very large Steam Ploughing Engines working over the weekend in the field.

Our very own Hop garden that has been nurtured every day by a couple of dedicated committee members, is very green and shows the hops growing up the strings at least 10" to 12", and a selection of Narrow Tractors that were built for working in hop gardens, orchards and vinyards.

Make sure you stay around until the end of the show, as each day at 4.30pm as the working field will be a display of some Tanks and Army vehicles driving as if they are on a mission.

We have a very good selection of food outlets for everyone's individual choice, find the catering tents opposite the beer tent. The beer tent is supplying refreshments all weekend, with a great sound of music from local Bands, musicians, dancers, and solo artists.

Don't miss bingo in the beer tent at 5pm this year!

Our superb team is made up of volunteer committee members who give up their free time throughout the year and have worked very hard to put Rural Past Times 2026 on at our dedicated show ground, again they have been working tirelessly to bring it all together for this weekend. Any money raised will be given to charities chosen jointly by the committee, last year we managed to give £20,000.00 to a variety of charities listed in this programme.

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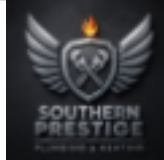

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Ploughing Steam Engines

We are very excited to have a pair of steam ploughing engines attend the show this year as our special guest! Find them in the ploughing field all weekend.

Read below for the history of these amazing machines.

Before the arrival of the modern tractor, steam power transformed farming across Britain. Steam ploughing engines were among the most impressive agricultural machines ever built, combining immense power with ingenious engineering to cultivate land that horses alone could never manage efficiently.

Unlike a traction engine that pulled implements directly behind it, steam ploughing was usually carried out using two engines working as a team.

Positioned on opposite sides of a field, each engine operated a powerful winding drum. A steel cable ran between them, attached to a balance plough or cultivator. The engines alternately wound in and paid out the cable, pulling the implement across the field one way, then back again. This method provided excellent traction, avoided compacting the freshly worked soil, and allowed heavy clay land to be cultivated even in difficult conditions.

The photographs show the remarkable scale and elegance of these machines. Their large spoked wheels, towering chimneys, exposed gearing, and polished flywheels were all designed for reliability and power. Skilled engine drivers and steersmen worked together to keep the engines in perfect synchronisation, ensuring smooth operation throughout the day.



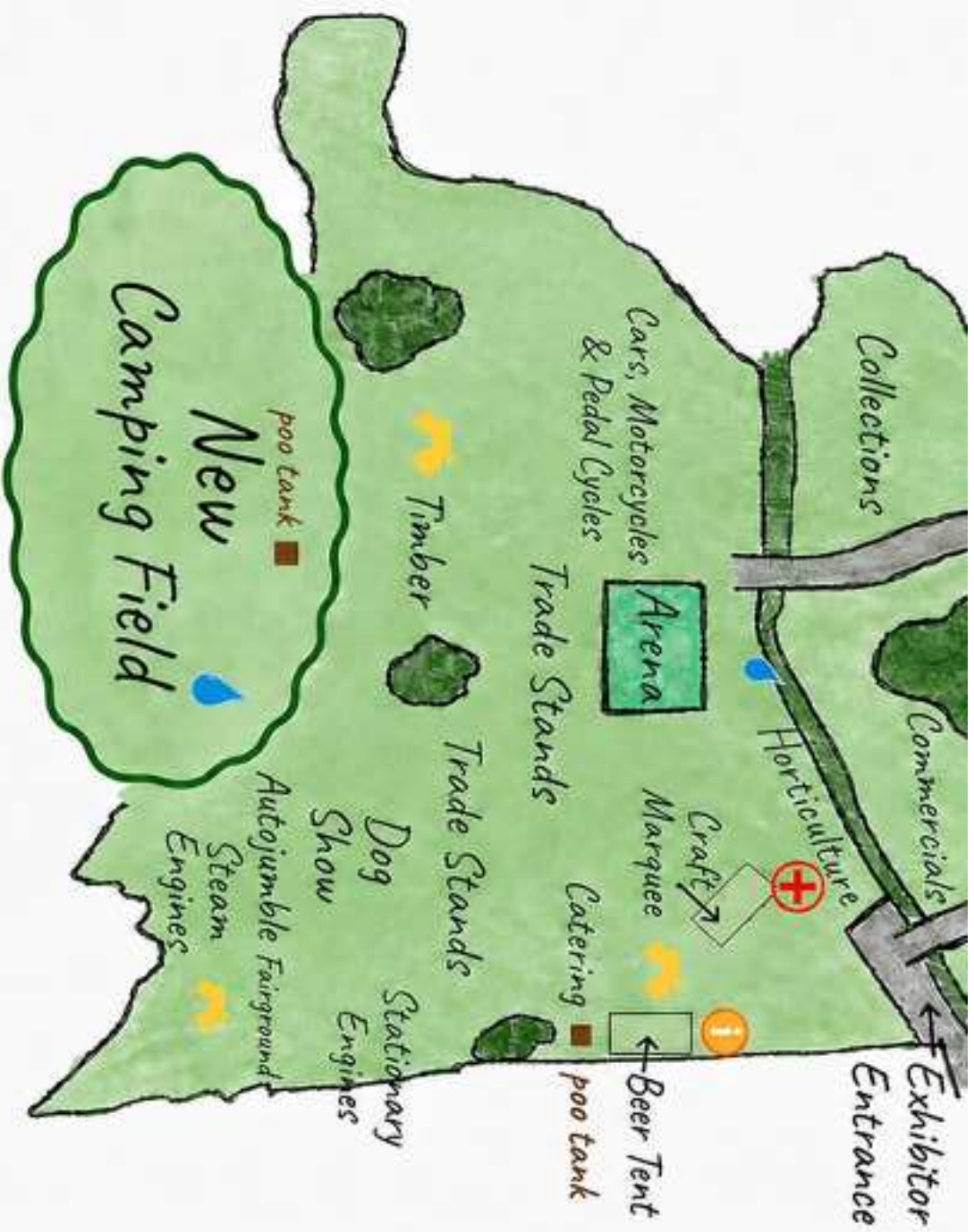
Ploughing Steam Engines

Steam ploughing reached its peak during the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. Manufacturers such as Fowler, Aveling & Porter, Burrell and Marshall produced engines that became the backbone of many agricultural contracting businesses. A contractor could travel from farm to farm with a pair of engines and plough hundreds of acres during the season, bringing mechanical power to areas where few farms could afford their own equipment.

Although internal combustion tractors eventually replaced steam in the 1920s and 1930s, steam ploughing engines remain icons of Britain's engineering heritage. Today, dedicated enthusiasts carefully restore and preserve these magnificent machines, allowing new generations to experience the sight, sound and smell of working steam. Watching a pair of steam plough engines working together is a reminder of an era when craftsmanship, teamwork, and engineering ingenuity transformed agriculture.



The images beautifully capture this contrast between past and present—historic steam machinery working the land while modern agricultural structures stand in the background. It is a fitting reminder that although farming technology continues to evolve, the pioneering achievements of the steam age laid the foundations for the mechanised agriculture we know today.
